

ARTICLE XV

SUBMISSION OF CHARTER TO VOTERS

- Section 15.01 A. The Charter Commission, in preparing this Charter, concludes that it is impractical to segregate each subject so as to permit a vote of "yes" or "no" on each individual subject, separately. Therefore, it should be adopted in its entirety to enable this Charter to work and function as it is necessary. For these reasons, the Charter Commission directs that this Charter be voted upon as a whole, and that it should be submitted to the qualified voters of the City at an election to be held on Tuesday November 6, 2001. The following ballot form shall be used by the City Council as specified per State law:
