RESOLUTION IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON ENFORCEMENT OF THE CITY OF SOCORRO, TEXAS, ORDINANCE NO. 170, RELATED TO PARKED TRUCKS

THE STATE OF TEXAS §

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council of the City of Socorro, Texas that Ordinance No. 170, Establishing Truck Routes Within the Municipal Limits of the City of Socorro, Texas, is ambiguous and subject to various interpretations; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that residents of Socorro may be subjected to the criminal charges, fines and penalties set forth in Ordinance 170, including a possible fine of \$500.00; and,

WHEREAS, this section of Socorro's Ordinance needs to be reviewed, evaluated and amended; and,

WHEREAS, in order to provide sufficient time for the City Council and the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Socorro, Texas to fully investigate this situation and to develop and implement appropriate Rules and Regulations for parking trucks within all districts within the City of Socorro, the City Council desires to impose the Moratorium described below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOCORRO, TEXAS:

1. That the matters and facts stated in the preamble above are found, determined and adjudicated to be true and correct.
2. That a Moratorium be, and same is hereby, ordered regarding enforcement of Ordinance 170, for ***a period of ninety (90) days from the 5th day of June 2009***, for the purpose of permitting the Socorro City Council and the Socorro Planning & Zoning Commission sufficient time to review current Rules and Regulations regarding the parking of trucks within the City of Socorro, Texas and to impose appropriate regulations in all residential zones, commercial zones, industrial zones and unclassified properties in the City of Socorro, Texas.

3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


